PhD studentships in Engineering are available as part of the *Marie Skłodowska-Curie ITN* action **TRUSS** (Training in Reducing Uncertainty in Structural Safety, 2015-2018). The recruitment will be done on a competitive basis across all applicants for all 14 projects advertised at <http://trussitn.eu/vacancies/>, which also contains details on eligibility conditions and how to apply.

The prestigious *Marie Skłodowska-Curie* programme offers highly competitive and attractive salary and working conditions. PhD tuition fees are covered and the research project is aimed at defending a thesis and obtaining a PhD degree. In addition to their individual scientific projects, all positions will benefit from further continuing training, which includes internships and secondments (All PhD students will be seconded at least once at another partner site), a variety of training modules as well as transferable skills courses, active participation in workshops and conferences, and exposure to large enterprises, SMEs and Universities from different European countries involved in TRUSS.
