








Communications

UCD Extenuating Circumstances Process

- UCD has a process called Extenuating Circumstances which allows students to apply for consideration of **unforeseen circumstances** that have had a serious effect on their ability to engage with their modules.
- Grounds for consideration must be serious, beyond your control suitable supporting evidence must be provided in order to make an application.
- Applications are submitted online via SISWeb under Programme Services but students are encouraged to discuss directly with their Module Co-ordinator (Lecturer, Studio Tutor etc) directly.




